LV=`mount | awk '{if ( $3 == "$MNTPT" ) print$1}' | cut -f4 -d '/' | cut -f2 -d
'_'`

umount $MNTPT

lvremove $VG/$LV

vi /etc/fstab          # Remove corresponding line
