

How do I add ethtool settings to a network device permanently?

ethtool can be used to set options for many types of Ethernet devices. The `/etc/sysconfig/network-scripts/ifcfg-ethX` files can have the ethtool settings added to them so that the settings are saved and used every time the device is activated.

For example, the command:

```
ethtool speed 100 duplex full autoneg off
```

sets the eth0 device to 100Mbps, full duplex, with auto negotiation off. To have the initialization scripts set this every time the eth0 device is activated, add a line to the `/etc/sysconfig/network-scripts/ifcfg-eth0` file:

```
ETHTOOL_OPTS="speed 100 duplex full autoneg off"
```
